DUES NOTICES FOR SECOND HALF OF 2009

As is our usual custom, membership renewal notices for the 2nd half of 2009 (including those who didn't renew in the first half of 2009 and are receiving a second notice) will be mailed out in June.

Regardless of when your membership expires in the second half of 2009, we extend it until the end of that month in 2010, so you never are penalized for paying 'early'. And if your membership HAD expired in the past, we simply reset your renewal date from a year from the end of the month we receive your latest check.

We send notices to people TWICE in case they missed it the first time around. Members who no longer renew have their emails added to our "email only" list after two attempts at mailing the dues notices.

Your annual dues help the club run events and such that are not covered by the normal YRE fees. Do you know we have to pay \$94 a year for our PO Box, \$50 annual AVA dues, \$60 to maintain our website annually, etc?

So although all our walks can be done for free, this is why we really appreciate your supporting the club as a dues paying member!

Calendar of Club Events

We are sometime asked what a "Group Walk" (as opposed to a Year Round Event, or YRE) is. "Group Walk" * means all meet and signup together at the same time, get a map and start together, then you proceed at your own pace. There are NO GUIDES for this kind of walk, nor does a group have to stay together. We usually have fast walkers, slow walkers, and medium walkers, there's almost always someone you can walk with if you join us for your first time in a GROUP WALK! ; "Event's" are single walks especially sanctioned by the club. AVA credit is provided, and these are usually a one-time deal ; perhaps repeated yearly. Items in **BOLD RED** are updates from the previous newsletter! **CONFIRMED** events are in bold face; TENTATIVE (planning dates) are listed in plain

text—usually they'll become "confirmed" in a month or so. Due to unforeseen circumstances, we always reserve the right to cancel ANY event, but try very hard not to do so with CONFIRMED events.
