"Group Walk" * means all meet and signup together at the same time, get a map and start together, then you proceed at your own pace. There are NO GUIDES for this kind of walk, nor does a group have to stay together. We usually have fast walkers, slow walkers, and medium walkers, there's almost always someone you can walk with if you join us for your first time in a GROUP WALK!; "Event's" are single walks especially sanctioned by the club. AVA credit is provided, and these are usually a one-time deal; perhaps repeated yearly. Items in BOLD RED are updates from the previous newsletter. CONFIRMED events are in bold face; TENTATIVE (planning dates) are listed in plain

text—usually they'll become "confirmed" in a month or so. Due to unforeseen circumstances, we always reserve the right to cancel ANY event, but try <u>very</u> hard not to do so with CONFIRMED events.
