

#### NOTES FROM THE NERD PHIL HAIT, AVA NORTHEAST REGION DIREC-TOR

Good morning everyone!

Earlier this week the NEC had a conference call meet- AVA's largest clubs in action! ing primarily to review & approve the proposed AVA Budget for the upcoming fiscal year. The budget was based on a number of things including the current year On the conference call, I asked the question about the trend for walk participation income. In reviewing the policy/requirement for AVA Regional re-alignment. It current year which concludes at the end of June, AVA seemed quite appropriate after reviewing the budget has a budget shortfall of nearly \$40,000. A Certificate of situation. Quite simply, the NEC can re-align, consoli-Deposit was cashed in May to cover this deficit & put date & change regions through a simple vote. This is additional money toward next year's budget which how the Northeast Region was created in 1989. Club shows a \$60,000 potential shortfall.

I know that many clubs have had to do similar acts to continue to pay the bills. A lot of discussion was had about various ways to increase income. The easiest way to correct the situation is to increase paid walkers at events & to increase AVA membership. Easier said than done! When potential national sponsors are approached about becoming a partner with AVA, their first question is about the size of membership in the organization. The only way to answer that is with the AVA membership & with the number of event books redeemed. Both categories have declined substantially in recent years. Any other ideas out there?

In IVV news, Joseph Gigl, IVV President died suddenly on June 12 of an apparent heart attack. Claude Raymond, one of three IVV Vice Presidents has taken over the duties of President on an interim basis.

Curt Myron & Wayne Holloway have been leading the search committee for the new AVA Executive Director to replace Jackie Wilson who is retiring at the end of August. They have concluded the interviews after numerous qualified candidates were put through the process. An offer has been made to the leading candidate & they expect that this person will join AVA full time on See you on the trails, August 1, 2010. This allows for a month of overlap with Jackie which will be extremely helpful for a smooth transition. No name has been released & won't until the haitp@verizon.net paperwork is complete.

The next NEC Meeting will be on October 1 & 2 in Colonie, NY at the Best Western Hotel on Wolf Road. Meeting times are being finalized so that the NEC can attend the ESCV Octoberfest walk in Menands on Saturday morning. It will be a great opportunity for the NEC & the ESCV members to meet mingle & share volkssporting ideas. If you want to see your elected officers in action, this will be an excellent opportunity. The new Executive Director will also be in attendance to see how one of

approval is not required nor is an AVA bi-law change required. The bi-laws indicate that a minimum of 6 regions but no more than ten are required. There are cost savings to AVA if less RDs are required to travel to the NEC Meetings & AVA biennial convention in addition to administrative costs. The discussion was referred to a study group. The topic will come up at the next NEC Meeting for further discussion and potential action.

The Northeast Region is the smallest in number of clubs & I do not expect the club count to increase in the near future. In fact I expect the count to decrease. Combine this with the inability to attract potential candidates for Region Director & region nominating committee, I can see the near term consolidation. If you want to see the Northeast Region continue intact, the time is now to take the next step. I am term limited and cannot continue.

Now is the time to start the process for renewing the YREs for 2011.

AVA bylaws require that each region have a nominating committee 9 months prior to the convention which means that this Octo-

ber at least

one person from the Northeast Region needs to be identified who will coordinate information to the national nominating committee.

There are two components to this position.

Contact all of the region clubs to determine if anyone is interested in being a national officer. Forward the names of any individual interested in running for one of the four national officer positions to the national coordinator.

Contact all of the region clubs to solicit candidates for region director. Forward the names of all candidates for northeast region director to national coordinator & later to poll the region clubs for their vote on the candidates.

All candidates for either category need to be identified by the beginning of 2011 to allow for the proper time to have their individual qualifications reviewed. Candidates will be asked to prepare a short biographical sketch for publication in The American Wanderer.
