THE 2011 VOLKSSPORT CLUB OF WEST POINT INCENTIVE CARD (REWARD BOOK) PROGRAM

he Volkssport Club of West Point (VCWP) obtained approval for an incentive (reward) card program! Completion of the reward book will earn a gold star 2011 hat pin.

Reward books are free.

Completion of the book encourages VCWP members to support the VCWP's local YRE walks and Traditional Event walks.

But, you do not have to be a VCWP member to complete the program.

Our hope is that the program will be self-supporting via walkers walking for credit or making donations if walking for free.

Eligibility: Complete 9 different VCWP - YRE walks. Remaining 3 walks may be Traditional Event walks held by VCWP or repeat of a VCWP - YRE. (12 VCWP walks total) No more than two stamps per year for the same YRE

will be accepted. If you completed VCWP walks in 2011 prior to the books becoming available, you may write in the walk location and date for those walks. You must have registered (walk box log) for those walks. After you receive (or print) the book please record walks by imprinting event stamp on numbered lines and hand write the name and date of the walk on the location line. All pins will be ordered Feb 2012.

SPECIAL EVENTS COMMENCING JANUARY 2012

(WITH CREDIT FROM THE WALK N' MASS NEWSLETTER "FOOTNOTES" OF APRIL 2011)

he following are special events commencing on 1 January 2012:

- Celebrating Golden Cinemas: any event that passes a building that currently or historically served as a classic movie theater, defined as being built more than 50 years ago, qualifies.
- Works Progress Administration Project: The WPA during its 8 years of activity constructed or repaired 651,00 miles of roads, 124,031 bridges, 125,110 public buildings, 8,192 parks, and 853 airports. Any walk route that passes or traverses a WPA project qualifies. This special event will require some research..
- America's Bakeries: Any walk that passes a local bakery qualifies; Chains, such as "Krispy Kreme" or "Panera Bread" do not qualify.
- Struttin' Down Main Street: Any walk or bike event that traverses a town's main street for at least one block qualifies.
- Strolling Somewhere Over the Rainbow: Any walk route goes through or by a place named with a color qualifies, such as "Red River", "Blue Hills", Orange, etc.
- Classic America Diners: To qualify, the word "diner" must be in the name of the establishment. Fast food chains and donut shops do not qualify.

1)Treasurer's Report

A "Group Walk" * means all meet and signup together at the same time, get the trail directions and start together, then you proceed at your own pace. There are NO GUIDES for this kind of walk, nor does a group have to stay together. We usually have fast walkers, slow walkers, and medium walkers, there's almost always someone you can walk with if you join us for your first time in a GROUP WALK! "Events" are one-time only walks. AVA credit is provided, and these are usually a one-time deal, perhaps repeated.
